What is a Google Chrome Extension?

Chrome extensions are programs you can install on your browser to enhance its functionality for various applications. These small software programs have specific functional parameters and can act either on a particular page or browser-wide whenever you're using Chrome.





How does a Chrome extension work?

- When you download an extension to Google Chrome, you can modify how the program operates to make your web experience more seamless and easier to use.
- Extension fulfills a narrowly defined purpose. While an extension can contain multiple components, it must contribute to a common goal on the browser.
- Goals include modifying existing program behaviors to adding new features that optimize your workflow








What is the purpose of the RSI extension?

- Submit orders to RSI without login into the RSI portal
- Check Status of an order
- Link to view Completed Reports
- See historical reports previously placed with the extension
- Works with <u>any</u> HRIS / ATS platform
- Scrapes applicant email / phone number from the current webpage

























- 1. Add applicant name
- 2. Select background screening custom package
- 3. Select work location system supports multilocation child accounts, if needed
- 4. Submit
- System then sends Quick App email / text from the RSI system to applicant to capture personal data and authorization forms









- Check the status of a request
- Order ID available when needing to submit questions to RSI help Desk









You can view the report as searches are being completed. Will show either "Complete" or "Partial" Once completed, you will select "View Report" to open the report in a separate tab.





Security / Applicant Data

- Because the Google Chrome extension only scrapes applicant email and phone number there are no concerns regarding security of applicant personal data.
- The RSI Quick App is a secure link sent from the RSI platform to capture applicant data sent to RSI for processing and remains in our SOC 2 compliant servers.





Implementation

- RSI client must be on our Tazworks platform
- Onboarding call with Integration specialist
 - Package needs, location setup, etc.
 - Potential new platform setup and training discussion
- Credentials provided to client for login requirements
 - Download the RSI Google Chrome Extension (no cost)
- Cost \$1.50 per ordered report
 - Added to package cost
 - \$350 on-time setup fee

If already on the RSI Tazworks platform, clients can be setup within 2 weeks





Questions

- Does the extension support a la carte ordering? No, must be custom packages
- Does the extension support Drug Screening? Yes, if the drug test is included in the package.
 This will also include applicant self-scheduling to streamline the ordering process.
- What is Quick App? Our applicant self-entry portal. The QuickApp invitation will prompt the
 applicant to log in, enter their information, sign background screening related forms, and schedule their
 drug tests (if applicable).
- Does the completed report feed into my HRIS/ATS system? No, the final report will be housed within the RSI Chrome Extension; however, once a completed PDF is available you can simply save it and add to your employee's file.
- I have multiple locations or companies I order for, how am I able to separate those? We can set up as many child accounts as you need, each can have a unique name, separate invoicing, or one invoice separated by the location.





Reminders



- Works with any HRIS / ATS platform
- Can add "child accounts" for multiple locations
- Send email invitation (Quick App) to your applicant for electronic order processing based on custom packages
- Link to Completed Report within the Chrome Extension
- Cost \$1.50 per report, \$350 one-time setup fee
